Tournament Ball: Wilson US Open

Singles Scoring Format: Best of 3 tie-break sets in all singles matches

Doubles Scoring Format: Best of 3 tie-break sets in all round robin matches, main draw Quarter Finals, Semi Finals, Final and 3rd/4th playoff. Doubles will be played as 2 tie-break sets and 10-point match tie-break in non-medal matches, and ties where the score is 2-0 after singles. Doubles played Wednesday onwards that do not impact medal positions shall be played as 2 tie-break sets and 10-point match tie break.

Player Accreditation

Player Accreditations for all team players can be collected by Captains at The Polo Club between 9am-2pm on Saturday 25 April 2020.

T-Shirts will be provided to all players in the Team Event by Green Grass Brand of West Palm Beach. The ITF will request shirt sizes from Team Captains in the weeks prior to the event. If a team does not respond to the email requesting sizes, there is no guarantee that the size required can be provided.

Practice Courts & Match Balls

All venues for the Team Event will host practice on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Transport will be available from official tournament hotels to venues. A transport schedule will be available prior to the tournament.

Airport Travel and Transport Details

Recommended Airports

- Fort Lauderdale (FLL) International Airport approximately 20 minutes from Boca Raton
- Palm Beach International (PBI) Airport approximately 20 minutes from Boca Raton
- Miami (MIA) International Airport approximately 45 minutes from Boca Raton

Tri-Rail

Available from Miami and Fort Lauderdale airports to Boca Raton. Cost is approximately \$5-10 per person. 'Boca Raton' station is located on Yamato Road. Uber of Lyft is available from Boca Raton Tri-Rail station to official hotels and will cost approximately \$15-20 per vehicle.

Brightline Trains

Tournament Travel and Transport Details

Transport to Palm Beach Gardens for Individual Event

Buses will depart from the Official Hotels in Boca Raton on Friday 1 May (PM) and Saturday May 2 (at 9am) for players playing in the Individual World Championships being played in Palm Beach Gardens (45 minutes from Boca Raton). The venues for the Individual Championships in Palm Beach Gardens can be seen here

Unless you have your own car, transportation for the Individual Championships will only be provided from the Official Hotels in Palm Beach Gardens. It is not recommended that you remain in Boca Raton if you are playing the second week in the Individual Championships.

Bus transportation from official Boca Raton hotels to hotels and sites in Palm Beach Gardens. Spaces on the bus must be reserved by 12.00 noon on Friday 1 May 2019. Cost of bus is \$20 per person which can be booked at the Tournament Desk of each Team Cup venue.

Sports Medicine Physiotherapists

A Sports Medicine Physiotherapist (Trainer) will be on site from Sunday 26 April 2020 until the end of the tournament. Physio will be on site 30 minutes before play and until 10 mins after the end of play each day.

Treatment to players on court during matches will not be charged.

Players can book a private treatment with a Physio at a cost of \$25.00. Payment must be made prior to the treatment commencing by cash or card. More information will be available on site.
